## Farm to Food Assistance Learning Lab Application

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The Farm to Food Assistance Learning Lab will support and learn from people working on initiatives that buy food from local farmers and make it accessible to food insecure communities, with an emphasis on racial equity and community driven solutions. Through this 12-month Lab, the Wallace Center will provide funding, mentorship, and peer support to folks working on these efforts, including those that are funded by USDA's Local Food Purchasing Assistance Cooperative Agreement program (LFPA). We'll also collaborate with you to gather and measure the impact and challenges of this strategy so we can all better tell the story of this work. If you are working on a program that aims to address food insecurity and farm viability for BIPOC producers, apply now!

#### You'll receive:

- Peer connection: a community of people doing similar work in a confidential, supportive space
- Financial assistance: \$20k to strengthen and advance your farm to food assistance (F2FA) efforts
- Technical assistance: dedicated advisors and monthly group calls to increase organizations' knowledge and capacity for design, collaboration, and implementation of F2FA projects
- In Person Retreat to help participants expand their network, deepen their connections and learn from their peers (Lead applicant only)

#### **Eligibility:**

- This learning lab is open to Local Food Purchase Assistance program
  implementers OR Organizations that have at least one year of engagement in
  managing (non-Local Food Purchase Assistance) farm to food assistance
  programs that are paying farmers fair market value for their products and
  connecting them with food assistance programs in their communities.
- We'll consider applications from a broad range of organizations, including but not limited to nonprofits, for-profits, faith-based organizations, mutual aid organizations, food hubs, food banks, community-based organizations, state and tribal governments, and cooperatives.

Selection Criteria: Here are the criteria we will use to select from eligible applicants. Throughout your responses please demonstrate how your program is:

- · Paying farmers for food purchases vs requesting donations
- Demonstrating a commitment to racial equity and centering community driven solutions
- Working to create sustainable solutions that exist beyond short term funding streams
- Willing and able to share data about their operations including number of farmers, dollars of product, and number of people served per month.
- Planning to use grant funds (up to \$20k) to help your program and partners set up for long term success
